

The purpose of this tutorial is to demonstrate, step by step, how to filter the Crimewatch website to show arrests made by the Florence Police Department in a chronological fashion.

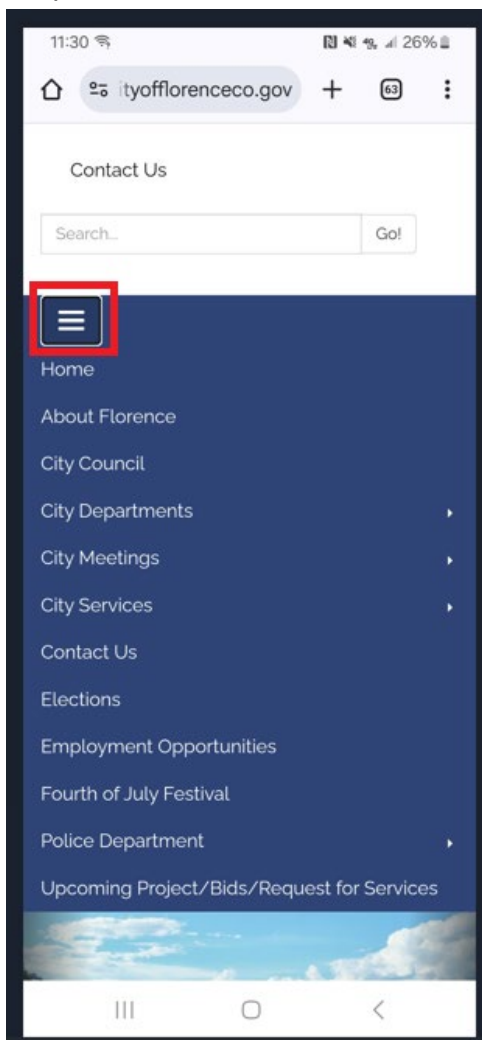
Note;this.is.the.MOBILE.version.of.this.tutorial;A.desktop.version.is.available.as.well;

(1) Go to the Crimewatch website for Fremont County, Colorado.

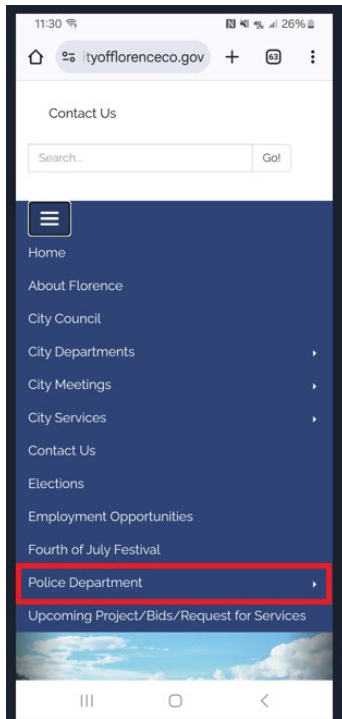
Crime watch can be found by:

- Clicking on this link [Fremont County | CRIMEWATCH.CO](#);
- Directly entering <https://crimewatch.net/us/co/fremont> into your address bar; or
- Through the City of Florence’s website (<https://www.cityofflorenceco.gov/>) by taking the following steps:

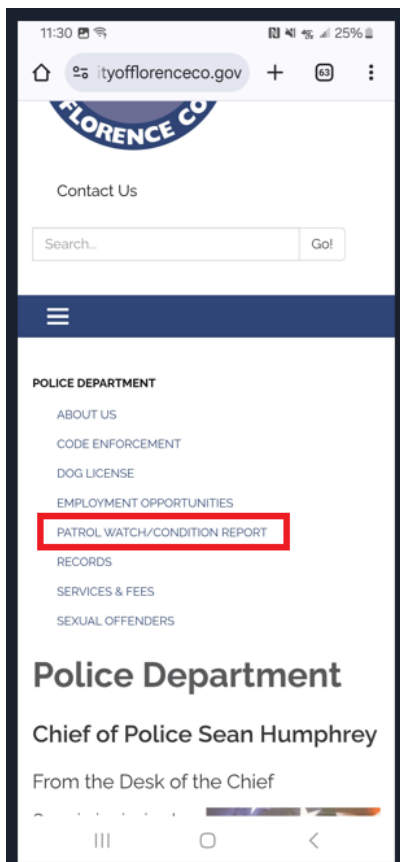
1. Select the hamburger menu at the top of the mobile website’s home screen to open the dropdown menu



2. Select “Police Department” from the dropdown menu



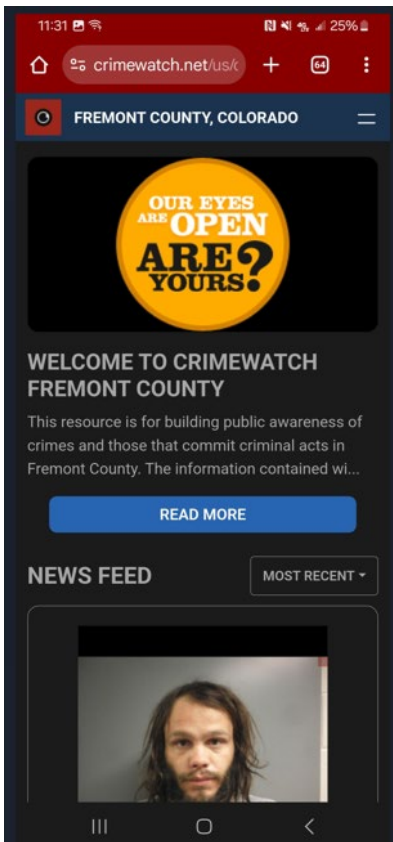
3. Select “Patrol Watch/Condition Report” from the menu at the top of the Police Department page:



4. Select the “Fremont County CRIMEWATCH CO” link on the next menu to appear:



Once on the Crimewatch mobile site, you should be viewing a screen like this:

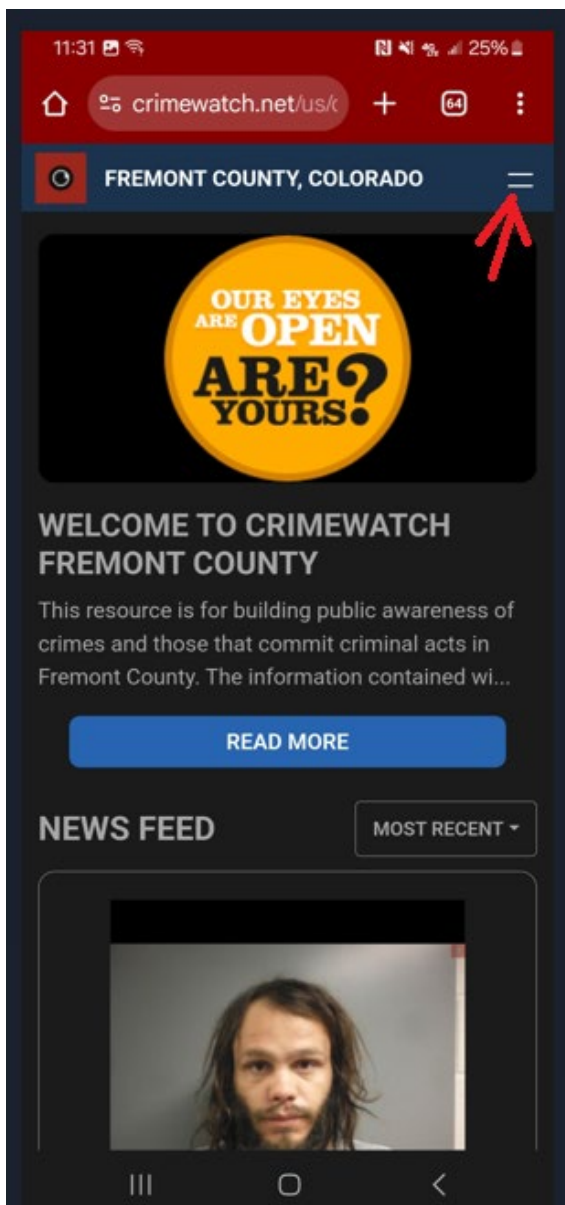


The “News Feed” includes arrests by all local agencies:

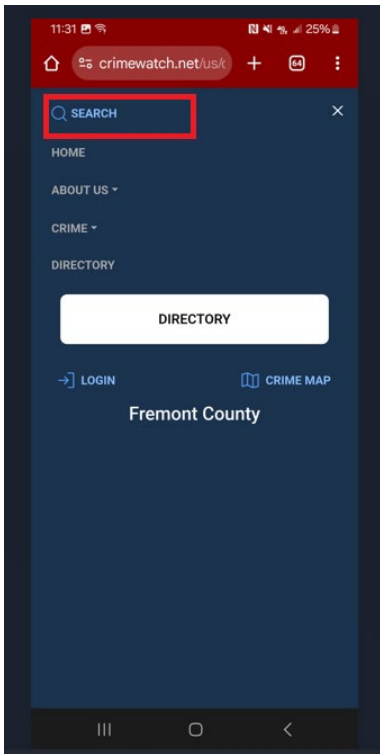
- Florence Police Department (FPD)
- Fremont County Sheriff’s Office (FCSO)
- Cañon City Police Department (CCPD)
- Custer County Sheriff’s Office (CCSO)
- Colorado State Patrol (CSP)

Note; Once you have reached this screen you may simply scroll through all of the arrests which are listed in reverse chronological order on the page. This tutorial assumes the user is looking for a means of more easily filtering the information;

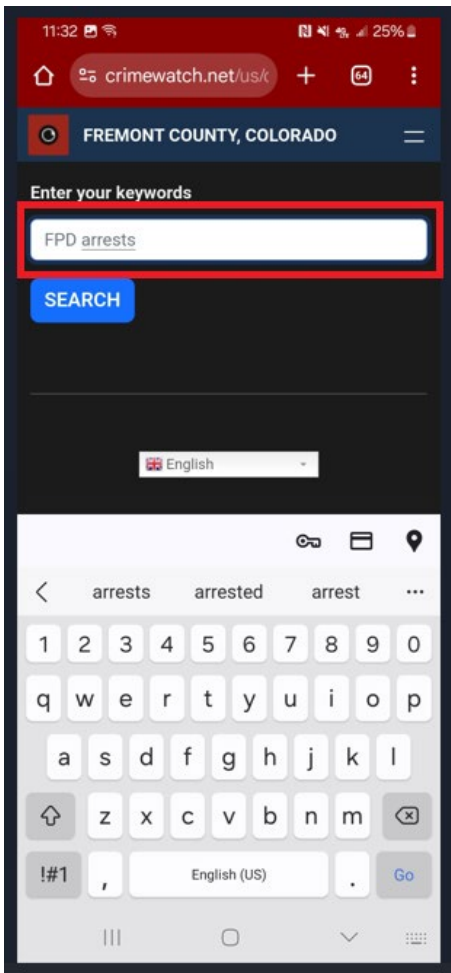
(2) In order to filter to just arrests by the Florence Police Department (FPD), select the two bars near the top left of the screen



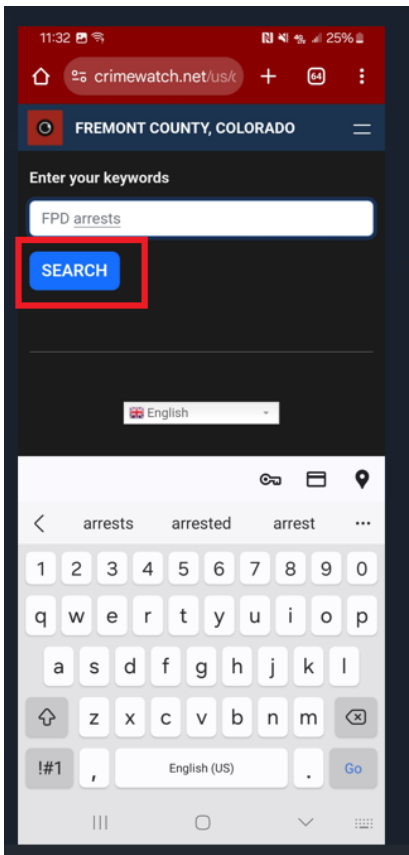
(3) This will open an additional menu. Select the “Search” function from this menu



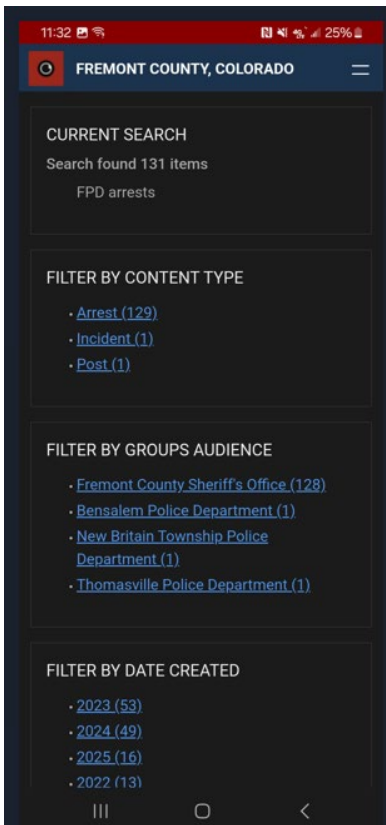
(4) Type “FPD arrests” in the search bar that appears



(5) Select “Search”



Once you hit “Search”, you should be viewing a screen similar to this:

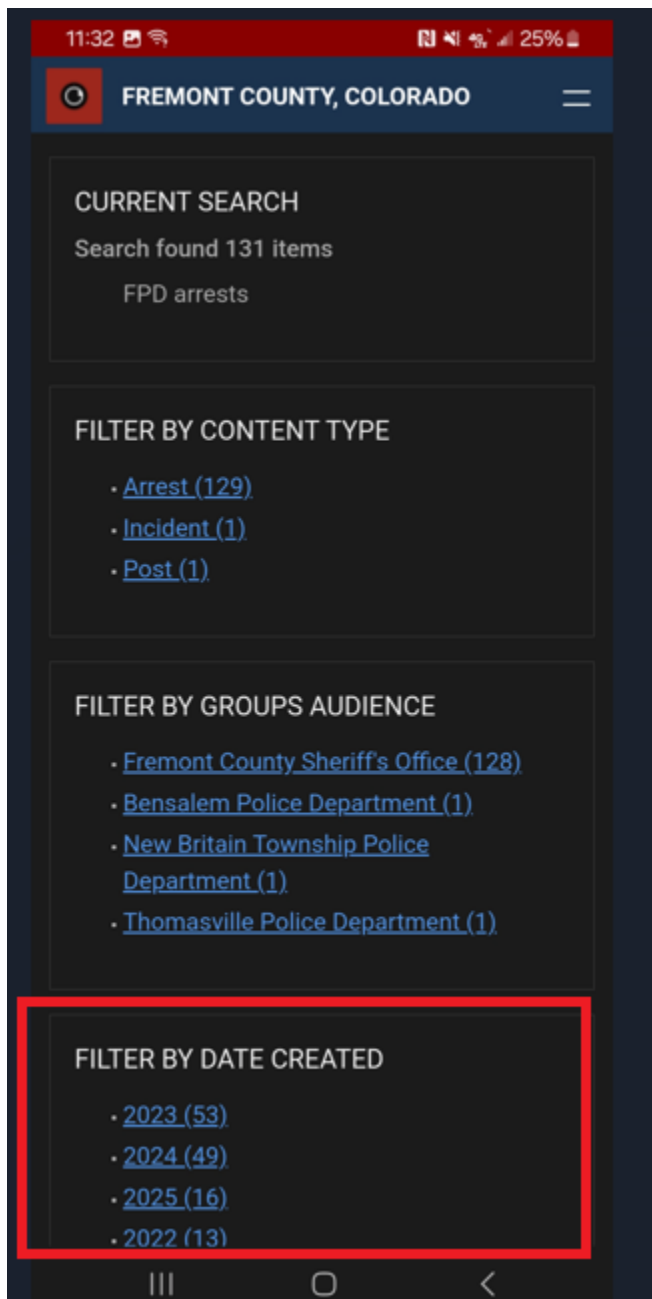


(6) At the top of the page, several additional menus should have appeared:

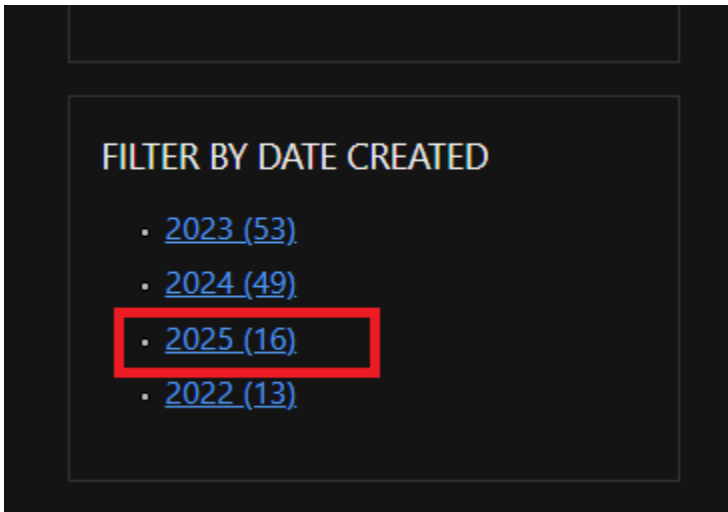
- Filter by Content Type
- Filter by Groups Audience
- Filter by Date Created
- Filter by Charges

Note: While each of these filters can be used for different purposes, the remainder of this tutorial assumes the user is looking to view arrests based on when they occurred;

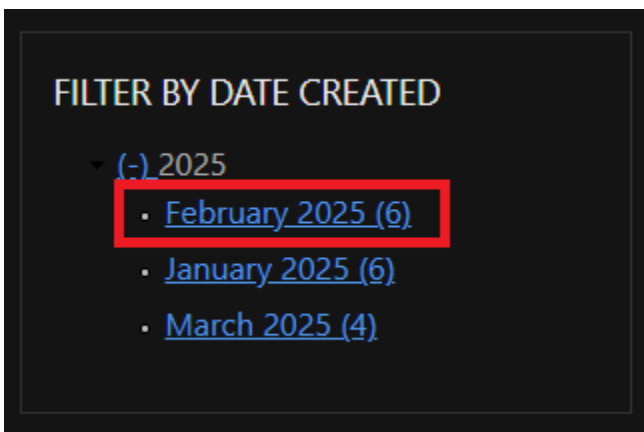
Scroll down the page (if necessary) until you are able to see the “Filter by Date Created Menu”



(7) Left click on the desired year. For the purpose of this tutorial, “2025” will be selected:



(8) This will then show all 2025 arrests by FPD, with additional options under the “Filter by Date Created” menu to show only arrests from a specific month in 2025:



Then specific days:



And even specific times on days such as that displayed above which have multiple arrests:
